

Town of Inlet Public Library Lending Policy

1. All overdue materials have to be returned before additional materials are taken out.
2. Long overdue library material is material two weeks past the return date. At the discretion of Library staff or members of the Library Board of Trustees, library privileges may be lost until all fines and charges are paid.
3. The penalty for late material is:
 - a. \$0.15 per book per day on overdue books and tapes for each day the library is open to a maximum of \$5.00 per item.
 - b. \$1.00 per day on overdue videos to a maximum of \$5.00 per item.
 - c. After one month items will be considered missing and the total cost of replacement of the library material will be charged to the library card number.
4. All library card holders must be over 5 years old. Parent/legal guardian permission is required prior to issuance of a card to a minor (a child 5-18 years of age). Parents/legal guardians are responsible for their minor children's use of the library, adherence to library rules and policies, and for all charges incurred by their minor children.
5. The above rules apply to all users of the library. At the discretion of the Library staff and members of the Library Board of Trustees, children or adults who abuse their library privileges may be denied use of the library.
